
(D) Alfred Bridges

Alfred married Julia Cooper in 1895 and in later life worked as a moulder in Bedford. They had 6 children all born in Wilstead and lived in Rose Cottage in Ivy Lane, Wilstead. It is thought there may have been a 7th child called Sidney but this has not been confirmed. As the supplied history of Alfred's descendents mainly consists of photographs they have all been kept under this section (**D**) to avoid any confusion.
