

(D) Alfred Bridges

Alfred married Julia Cooper in 1895 and in later life worked as a moulder in Bedford. They had 6 children all born in Wilstead and lived in Rose Cottage in Ivy Lane, Wilstead. It is thought there may have been a 7th child called Sidney but this has not been confirmed. As the supplied history of Alfred's descendents mainly consists of photographs they have all been kept under this section (D) to avoid any confusion.
