### (E) George Bridges

George Bridges was the second son of Thomas Bridges (2) and Edy Bennet (see (A) above). Born in Wilstead on 4 March 1821, he married Mary Brightman in Houghton Conquest on February 12 1843. Together they had two children in Wilstead - Ann (1849) and Samuel, before deciding to emigrate to Australia taking Mary's daughter Sarah with them. They left for Moreton Bay on the *Mary Somes* arriving in Queensland on 6<sup>th</sup> July 1852.

Essentially George was a successful man in what was German Station, Brisbane, Australia (later called Nundah). George acquired many acres of land and property and established taverns amongst
